

Troop 87 Campout Equipment List

1. One **tent** (including poles) per 2 people
2. One **groundcloth** per tent
3. **Dining fly** if expecting rain or extreme sun (including poles & ropes)
4. 50' **rope** (flagpole, misc. uses)
5. American **flag** (without pole)
6. Cook kit, including:
 - a) **Utensil kit** (knives, large spoon, spatula, tongs, ladle, scrubber, pot handles)
 - b) **Large pots** (to boil water)
 - c) **frying pan(s)** with handles (eggs, sausage, bacon, hamburger, etc.)
 - d) **griddle** (flat rectangle, have two that fit on Coleman stoves) (pancakes, bacon)
 - e) **medium & small pots** (simmering, keeping food hot)
 - f) **foil** (foil cooking, pot lids, other uses)
 - g) **grill** (when cooking over fire or charcoal, hamburgers)
 - h) **Dutch oven w/lid lifter** (one pot meals, biscuits, pizza, cakes) w/**charcoal**
 - i) **cutting board**
 - j) **stoves with fuel (propane or white gasoline)**
 - k) **matches or lighter**
 - l) **water storage container**
 - m) 3 **dishpans, dishwashing detergent, sanitizer** (tablets or bleach)
7. **Trash bags**
8. **Paper towels, napkins, toilet paper**
9. **Lanterns** (gas and/or electric), **with matches and/or working batteries**
10. **Hatchet and/or saw, hammer** (for tent pegs)
11. **First aid kit**
12. **Medical forms, Tour Permit**
13. **Training materials**
 - a) map & compass
 - b) Scout handbook, merit badge books

Other items:

Food (dry, fresh, refrigerated) - **CHECK TROOP FOOD BOX AND USE LEFTOVERS!**
Cooking oil, spices

Note: Not everything will be needed for every campout; this is a reminder list of possible items
